Sub: Under-graduation Programs – End of Year-Wise-Scheme – Re-admissions into III Year -
Consideration of Representation from Principals of varied UG colleges – Grant of
Permission to Students to Write Examinations – Regarding
Ref: Varied applications submitted by the Principals of UG colleges

Under reference cited, principals of varied under-graduate colleges have submitted applications to the university that they have given re-admission to III Year UG students under year-wise-scheme and forwarded their examination applications to the Controller of Examination (COE). As this was not done under intimation to the university, such students' candidature is not reflected in the nominal rolls available with the office of the COE. As such the examination forms are rejected and hall-tickets are not issued.

The principals are hereby informed that re-admissions are allocated by the Academic Branch of the university through notification/s issued at the beginning of the academic year, in a pre-defined process. The Vice-Chancellor, Kakatiya University has taken a serious note of the discrepancies on part of the principals in granting re-admission without following the code of practice. Such initiative is against the rule of admission specified by the university and will result in levying a penalty of Rs. 5,000.00 to 20,000.00 on repetition of such discrepancies.

However, the Vice-Chancellor, taking into consideration the future of the students, considered to ratify the re-admissions of III Year UG students under year-wise-scheme of the academic year 2017-18.

To streamline the admissions, a penalty of Rs. Rs. 2,000.00 (Rupees Two Thousands Only) per-student is to be paid and individual certificate of attendance be issued (Note: 75% of attendance is mandatory for any student to qualify for examinations). On receipt of the same, necessary initiatives of re-admission and issuance of hall-tickets will be taken-up by the university.
